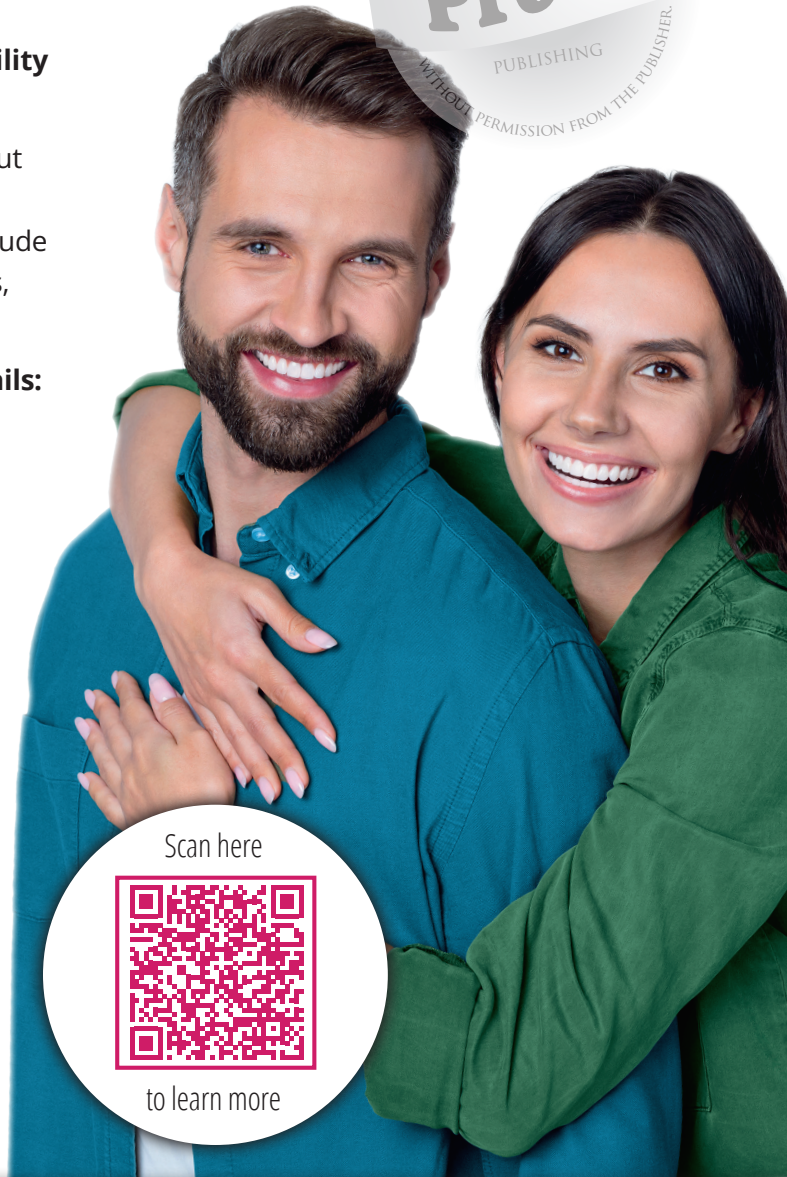
The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP): Expanded Eligibility & New Application Schedule

The CDCP offers dental benefits for eligible Canadians without insurance and with an adjusted net income under \$90,000, reducing financial barriers to essential care. Key services include cleanings, exams, fillings, root canal therapy, and extractions, with co-payments potentially based on family income.

NEW UPDATES! Expanded Coverage and Application Details:

- **Coverage Expansion:**
 - Now includes individuals aged 18–64.
- **Application Schedule for May 2025:**
 - **Aged 55–64:** Applications open on **May 1**.
 - **Aged 18–34:** Applications open on **May 15**.
 - **Aged 35–54:** Applications open on **May 29**.
- **Already Eligible to Apply:**
 - Residents aged 65 or older.
 - Individuals with a valid Disability Tax Credit certificate for 2023.
 - Children under 18.

Shrimp & feta orzo

- ¼ tsp pepper
- ½ cup feta cheese, crumbled

Instructions:

1. Cook orzo per directions. In separate pan, heat oil to medium, add tomatoes, garlic, & lemon juice. Bring to a boil, add shrimp, & simmer 5 minutes.
2. Drain orzo & stir into shrimp mix. Add feta, pepper & garnish with lemon slices. Enjoy!

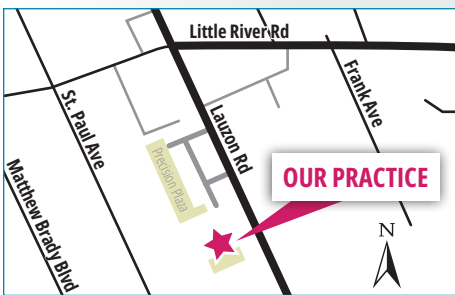

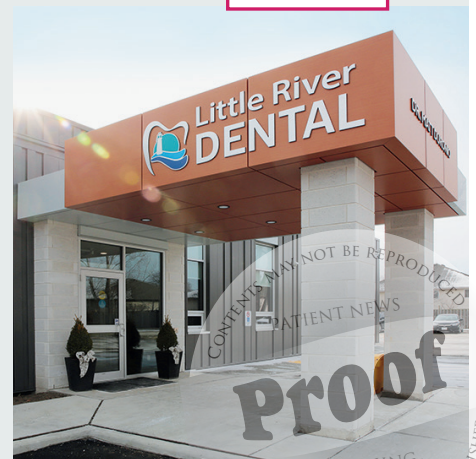
